

SOMO'S MEASUREMENT POLICY

- 1- Adopting internationally recognized standards (such as API, ISO, and ASTMetc) in custody transfer measurements, for exported / imported crude oil and petroleum product quantities.
- 2- Preparing and issuing all documents required for custody transfer measurement for exported/ imported crude oil and petroleum product quantities in accordance with API standards.
- 3- Seek to have custody transfer requirements to be incorporated in all SOMO's contracts and agreements.
- 4- Seek to secure custody transfer measurements (performed through certified meters, tanks measurement, and weighbridges) within maximum possible accuracy, in coordination with relevant oil sector companies.
- 5- Contracting with internationally certified third party inspection companies.
- 6- Studying claims and comments from SOMO's clients (in respect of cargo measurement) in coordination with oil companies in charge of custody transfer measurement at loading terminals prior to forwarding the proper reply.
- 7- Reviewing and updating all custody transfer measuring procedures in accordance with the most recent applicable published standards.
- 8- Seek to promote and develop the professional standards for custody transfer measurement personnel through specialized training courses.
- 9- Working to execute any other tasks required to apply custody transfer measuring requirements that matches the nature of SOMO's work.
